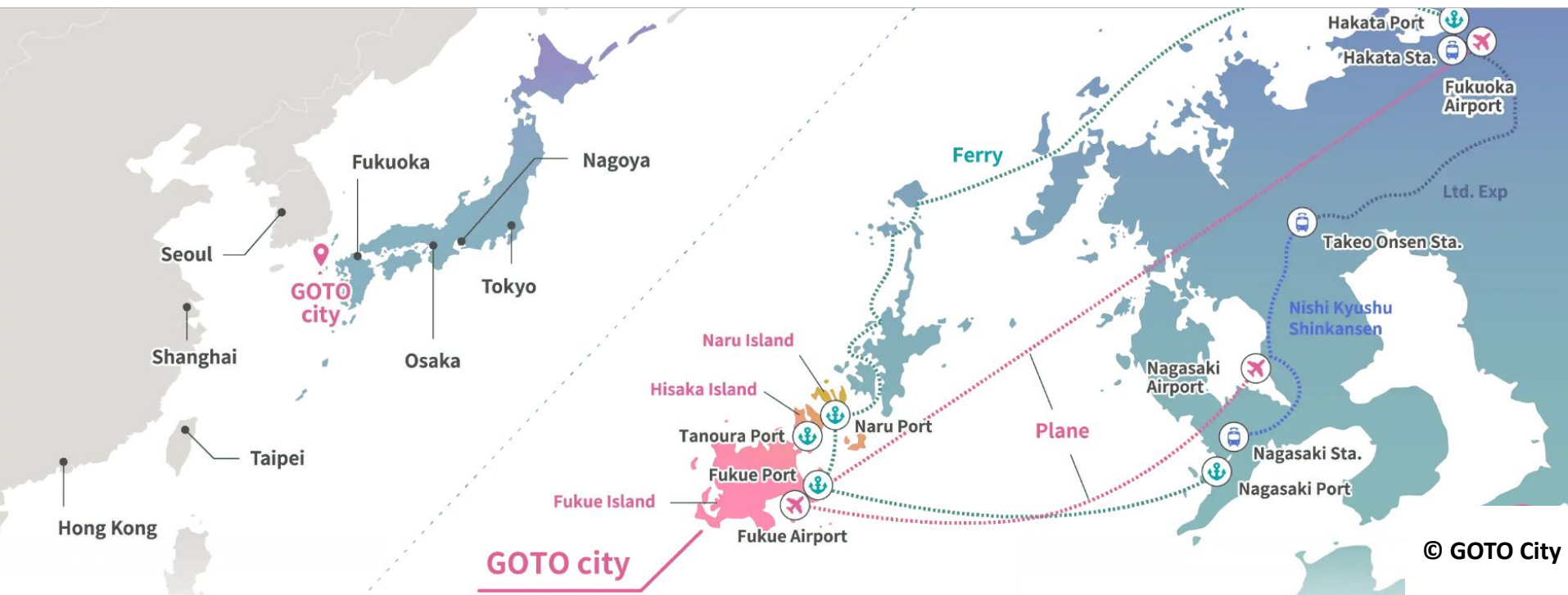




GOTO city Nagasaki Prefecture



Location of Goto city



Goto City stands on a group of outlying islands that are part of Nagasaki Prefecture. These charming islands offer harmony between the natural world and history, with their stunning sea and white sandy beaches, fun experiences in all four seasons, including fishing and marine sports, cycling, and trekking, and World Heritage churches. Visitors can also savor delicious gourmet food, such as fresh sashimi, Goto udon, and Goto Beef. The warm, local hospitality is another of this City's delights.

Goto: *Camellia* islands



The Goto Islands are home to more than 10 million camellia trees, the largest number in Japan. The camellia seeds, which have survived the harsh natural environment, are refined into the highest quality camellia oil, which is gentle to humans and good for the body.

Experience camellia, a specialty of Gotō, in a variety of ways, including making oil, making cosmetics from oil, and cooking with oil.



Goto: Gourmet islands



Surrounded by the sea on all sides, Gotō is a treasure trove of seafood. Not only the famous kibinago (Slender sprat), but also lobsters, bluefin tuna, and other delicious foods can be tasted freshly caught.

Goto is not only about seafood. Wagyu beef raised on the sea-breezed grasslands is said to be the “phantom Goto beef,” with only a few hundred cattle shipped annually, and its tender and flavorful taste is well known.

Since the entire western side of Gotō is covered by the sea, there are numerous sunset spots, including Osezaki Lighthouse, which has been selected as one of the 50 best lighthouses in Japan.

Of the approximately 130 churches in Nagasaki Prefecture, more than 50 are located on Gotō because of the history of religious beliefs that have been preserved over the more than 200 years of religious prohibitions that took place in the past.

It will be a journey that will move your heart with the strength of religious beliefs that overcame a history far more horrific than the persecution of Christianity during the Roman Empire.



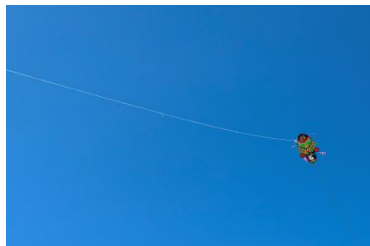

Three-day tour of the Goto Islands



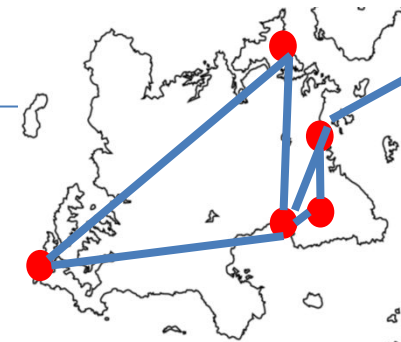
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Itinerary :

Day 1 : Nagasaki(Departure) – Goto

Take the Jetfoil to Fukue Port in Goto City. Meet the guide at Fukue Port and depart for the city.

Lunch is a phantom Goto beef lunch.

Get an overview of the features and history of Gotō at the Goto Tourism and Historical Materials Museum.

After visiting Fukue Castle and The Former Goto Lord's Residence and Garden, visitors can try their hand at painting a Brahmin kite at Furusatokan Pavilion in the Samurai Quarter. These kites are unique to the area and are made with the hope that the children will be energetic and active.

Dinner will be served at a tavern popular with the local community.

After dinner, we will go on the Onidake Night Tour. In Gotō, where there are almost no streetlights, the night sky is filled with a number of stars that cannot be seen in the city. Let's watch the seasonal constellations with a guide.

Overnight stay at hotel Colorit GOTO ISLANDS.

Day 2 : Goto – Goto

Hotel departure for Osezaki Lighthouse. The white lighthouse stands on a precipitous cliff jutting out into the sea, contrasting beautifully with the blue sea, and has been selected as one of the "50 best lighthouses in Japan."

Lunch at a local restaurant.

"Aroma of Landscape" Experience Plan. This is a tour to feel the original landscape of Gotō. After the tour, you will visit the Goto Tsubaki Distillery, which produces craft gin with a "story rooted in the local climate," and taste craft gin. After returning to Hotel Colorit, we will have an original dinner based on the concept of "local gastronomy".

Overnight stay at Colorit GOTO ISLANDS.

Day 3 : Goto – Nagasaki

Depart from the hotel to Onidake Four Seasons Village. Experience camellia oil making at Onidake Four Seasons Village.

Lunch will be Goto Udon.

Experience kite flying at Onidake. You can also fly a kite that you have painted yourself. Let's fly a Brahmin kite with a local person who will teach you how to fly a kite.

Depart from Onidake. Stop by the souvenir shop "Goto" to find memories of your trip.

From Fukue Port to Nagasaki by Jetfoil.

Arrival at Nagasaki Port. End of tour.
